During the conference speakers will concentrate on the following aspects of orchidology:

- Cultivation of orchids in general and also the cultivation of terrestrial orchids in particular
- Scientific aspects of the cultivation of orchids
- Scientific research regarding orchids
- Conservation of orchids
- · Scientific aspects of the conservation of orchids and biodiversity and
- Practical aspects of nature reserve management with the aim of conserving biodiversity
 with the emphasis on orchids. The role of Botanical Gardens in orchidology as well as
 the role of Orchid Societies should be addressed.

It is our aim to address problem areas in present day orchidology such as orchid hybrid registration; judging of the plethora of commercial available orchid plants; cultivar integrity, dwindling orchid society membership; the use of the internet and many other problems.

The conference will run simultaneously in two halls except during the plenary lectures – one each day. The four high quality keynote lectures of 50 minutes duration will be presented while the other lectures will be of 35 minute duration.

Specialist meetings are planned for the first three days from 17:00 to 21:00. Time will be allowed between lectures to allow registrants to change from one hall to the other. The two halls are in close proximity and they share a common foyer.

Poster boards will be available for persons that would like to submit a poster on any aspect of orchidology and prizes will be given to the best poster in a category.
